

SCHEDULE B: UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE – MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR DEAKIN COURSES

Approved by Academic Board on 11 April 2017. This schedule is made pursuant to the [Admission Criteria and Selection \(Higher Education Courses\) Procedure](#).

This Schedule expires at the end of Trimester 2 2017. The future version of this Schedule will commence from Trimester 3 2017 and is available via clause 2a of the Admission Criteria and Selection (HEC) procedure.

Section A: Undergraduate courses – minimum course entry requirements

To be eligible for a place in an undergraduate course, applicants must meet the minimum entry requirements set out below in:

- Table A2 - Course-specific minimum entry requirements for undergraduate courses (to apply in place of the standard minimum entry requirements in Table A1).
